

MPO RESOLUTION 2013-008
NASHVILLE AREA METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION
A RESOLUTION REQUESTING AMENDMENTS TO THE MAJOR ROADWAY
NETWORK AND FUNCTIONAL CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the Nashville Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is responsible for carrying out a comprehensive, cooperative, and continuing transportation planning process in the Nashville and Murfreesboro urbanized areas; and

WHEREAS, the planning area of the Metropolitan Planning Organization extends to include all parts of Davidson, Rutherford, Sumner, Williamson, and Wilson counties, and portions of Robertson and Maury counties; and

WHEREAS, the MPO's Major Roadway Network represents all major roads and streets within the planning area that are identified as being a "collector" or higher designation on the federal functional classification system; and

WHEREAS, the Nashville region has grown substantially requiring modifications to the Major Roadway Network to reflect changes in vehicular traffic patterns and roadway function; and

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Department of Transportation is responsible for facilitating modifications to the federal functional classification system for all areas within the State of Tennessee; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Executive Board of the Nashville Area Metropolitan Planning Organization does hereby request the Tennessee Department of Transportation to consider amendments the federal functional classification system of roadways as denoted on the attached map.
