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## ABOUT THE STUDY

Kicked off in March 2013, the Southeast Area Transportation and Land Use Study is the third “transportation and land use” study undertaken by the Nashville Area Metropolitan Planning Organization. The study draws together state, regional, and local partners to develop a preferred vision for growth and development in the area paralleling I-24 between I-40 and I-65 in Davidson, Rutherford, Williamson, and Wilson Counties. The southeast area is one of the region’s, and state’s, most important economic engines, and continues to experience strong population and job growth.

By taking steps now to coordinate plans for future development, participating agencies and jurisdictions can put in place the multimodal transportation improvements and land use policies necessary to support long-term prosperity and quality of life throughout the area.

Final study recommendations will be incorporated into the MPO’s *2040 Regional Transportation Plan*, as well as the comprehensive plans of local governments.
