Description:

Provide bicycle and pedestrian connection between the Rolling Mill Hill development and downtown Nashville (TN081). Establish pedestrian connections throughout the site to connect Hermitage Avenue to the greenway and Cumberland River Bluff. No work is to be done on Hermitage Avenue (TN133). Reconstruct Hermitage Avenue along the western edge of the Rolling Mill Hill site, including resurfacing, utility relocation, storm water and sewer separator capacity, and sidewalks (TN206).
