




- ❑ 30 Miles of Greenways & Multi-Use Paths
- ❑ Hundreds of Miles of Sidewalk

- ❑ 241,000 - Estimated Population
- ❑ Fastest Growing County in TN
- ❑ 35,000 (15%) Children Between the Age 5 and 14
- ❑ 19,000 (8%) Adults Over 65
